### **POINT OF NO RETURN**

As was said in earlier chapters, everyone will have to die because of Adam's sin in the Garden. (Romans 5:12 (BSB)

Right here is where the difference that changes lives come in. There will be judgment for everyone after they die, but those who accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior will have eternal life, as it says in Matthew 25:46 (BSB)

And they will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

The question. How did the righteous become righteous? Romans 3:22-24 (BSB)

### IT IS UP TO YOU
